

Characteristic of projects and activities:

One of the target area for FEED to establish a Nature Education Centre in the southern Thailand is in the Andaman sea included Krabi, Panga, puket, Ranong province. Hard Tai Muang National park, Krabi, is the most suitable place for the Andaman Nature Education centre for its Mangrove forest, mudflat, sand beach, marine turtle, and coral reef areas. Nature education centre model developed by FEED will be completed here, because of the rich of biodiversity and different kind of mangrove forest, wildlife habitat, wildlife species, different type of communities, and rare species of marine turtles.

Project's areas: Hard tai muang national park, Krabi province

Duration: 3-5 years (2013-2018)

Budget (Baht): 12,500,000 baht (Approximately 3.5 - 4,000,000 baht/ year)
